

BANGLADESH – NEPAL MISSIONS REPORT MARCH 2022

Brenda and I visited two congregations in and near Paragould, Arkansas on March 13. These were the Newton Street Church of Christ and the Liberty Church of Christ. We enjoyed wonderful fellowship with both churches and were also able to visit some very good friends in the area while there. I preached for the Center Hill Church in Paragould for 12 years before moving back to Alabama in 1992. We still have roots there.

I continued to teach two adult classes at Highland Park in March, preached one Sunday morning, and taught a Thursday morning ladies class one time during the month. On Sunday nights of the first half of the year I am teaching the book of Psalms. I am enjoying that study very much. I am also studying Acts with a Wednesday afternoon class at 3:30 p.m. Both these classes are being live-streamed through Facebook and You-Tube.

Covid numbers and restrictions are continuing to drop in South Asia. This past Monday there were reported only 56 new cases of Covid in Bangladesh. That country has dropped the requirement of quarantine for all air passengers coming into Bangladesh who show proof of vaccination. Nepal has allowed foreign travelers without quarantine for some time. We are now making tentative plans to return to Bangladesh and Nepal later this year.

The Happy Hills congregation in Bandarban District of Bangladesh has begun construction of a new wooden framed / tin covered building. Like others that we have mentioned lately they are providing much of the cost themselves, and we are assisting usually in the completion of the buildings.
