Thank all of you so much for helping us to continue our evangelism work in this country.

The work of the church in Romania is extremely hard, but very beautiful. There is no way to know the total number of Ukrainian refugees that have been assisted since the war in Ukraine began. The last number that I was given was 31,026 and I know that a few thousand more could be added to that number by now. This is only the work in Cluj-Napoca and I know that other congregations are helping many of the refugees as well. You will see pictures of much of the work in this issue. May God bless you for helping show the love of Jesus to all of these people.



City Center—Cluj-Napoca, Romania


The work that is being done with the Ukraine refugees in Cluj-Napoca, Romania has been supported thus far by 109 different individuals or congregations with total amounts of \$166,673. Money is being sent to Romania every week to ten days in order to respect the guidelines of the banks and government there. The work is going well and much good has been and is being done.
