Thoughts from Bill:

Divine and Human Remembering

Genesis 9:14-16; Ex. 2:23-25

M.H. Manser in *The Dictionary of Bible Themes* defines remembering as: "The process of recalling the past, especially the presence and activity of God in the history of his people. Remembering God's work in the past can lead to praise and rejoicing, and to hope for the future. God himself remembers." In this article we want to consider both divine and human remembering as set forth in Manser's article.

We first turn our consideration to *God's divine remembering*. Our text for this article reminds us that God has made covenants in the past with various people and that God always remembers His covenants and

promises (1 Chron. 16:15; Psa. 111:5; 2 Peter 3:9). Second, God *remembers his people* (Gen. 7:24-8:1; Isa. 49:15-16). God remembered Abraham as God was about to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah (Gen. 19:29). He remembered Rachel and Hannah when they were barren (Gen. 30:22; 1 Sam. 1:19-20). God remembers His people and will never leave them or forsake them (Deut. 31:8). However, there is one item that *God chooses not to remember, that is our forgiven sins* (Heb. 8:12).

We now turn our consideration to *human remembering* as we look at what all people, especially Christians, should remember. One must first remember *God and His holiness* (Deut. 8:18; Ps. 119:55; Jonah 2:7, Hab. 2:20; Isa. 6:3; 1 Pet. 1:16; Rev. 4:8). God also requires that one must remember His *past acts and deeds* (1 Chron. 16:12; Isa. 46:9). *God's commands* must also be remembered (Num. 15:38-40; Psa. 103:7-8). The *wrath of God* must be remembered (Deut. 9:7-8). Finally, *God's greatest gift* needs to be remembered (Jn. 3:16; Rom. 5:8).

Finally, we want to note *the importance and the outcome of remembering*. First, it is important to remember *our responsibilities to God and one another* (Num. 15:38; Eccl.12:1; Ac. 20:35; Gal. 6:2). Second, remembering is important *because it can produce repentance* (Rev. 2:5; 3:3). Finally, remembering *can produce hope for the future* (La. 3:21-24; Psa. 103:2,3; Heb. 13:2-3).

May God help us remember how great His goodness, power, and deeds are and may we remember our obligation to Him.

1 Chronicles 16:15—Remember His covenant forever, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations...
