Thoughts from Bill:

The Resurrection of Jesus

Acts 2:29-38

The turning point in Peter's sermon on the day of Pentecost over two thousand years ago was his preaching of the resurrected Christ. This is what changed the hearts of some of the very ones who had crucified our Lord. In this article we want to consider the resurrection of Jesus.

The resurrection of Jesus was always in God's plan and was foretold. The Psalmist in Psalms 16:10 wrote: "For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption." Hosea mentioned the fact that after three days Christ would be raised up (Hos. 6:2). While He was living, Christ foretold

His resurrection (Matt. 16:21; 12:40; Mk. 10:33-34; 14:27-28).

The apostles preached the resurrection as a fact and a certainty (Acts 4:33; 10:39-41; 17:2-3, 31; 1 Cor. 15:3-8). The resurrection of Christ was significant to the apostles' preaching and teaching, and it became the centerpiece of many of their lessons convincing people that Jesus was the Christ.

What were some of the results of the resurrection of Jesus? First, *God's power was demonstrated* (Acts 2:24; 1 Cor. 6:14; Eph. 1:19-20). Next the *sonship of Jesus was declared* (Acts 13:33; Rom. 1:4). Thirdly, *the Lordship of Jesus was declared* (Rom. 14:9). Finally, *the power of death was destroyed once and for all* (Rom. 6:9; Rev. 1:18).

Finally, we turn our thoughts to how believers benefit from the resurrection. The resurrection is *the foundation of salvation* (1 Pet. 1:21; 3:21). *Knowledge of the resurrection helps strengthen the believer* (Phil. 3:8-11; Heb. 13:20-21). The resurrection of Jesus *gives believers an intercessor in Christ* (Rom. 8:34; Heb. 7:25). Finally, the resurrection of Jesus benefits believers *by bringing them assurance of the resurrection to eternal life* (1 Cor. 6:14; 2 Cor. 4:14; 1 Thess. 4:14; 1 Pet. 1:3-4).

Thank God for the resurrection of Jesus, for without it we would of all men be most miserable [KJV] or pitiable [NKJV] (1 Cor. 15:19).

1 Corinthians 15:3-4—For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures...
