## Thoughts from Bill:

### Glorifying Jesus as . . .

**Lk. 2:11-14, 5:5, 19:37-38; 2 Thess. 1:12**

The Bible clearly teaches that both God and Christ are to be glorified. John records these words of our Lord in John 13:31: “. . . Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him.” In this series of lessons, we want to focus on glorifying Jesus as our Savior, Christ, King, Lord, and Master.

Glorifying Jesus as our Savior (Lk. 1:11). The term *savior* refers to one who delivers or rescues. When Joseph was considering how to handle the situation with Mary and her unborn child, an angel appeared to him and said in Matthew 1:21: “And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save

His people from their sins." The woman at the well in John 4:42 declared that Jesus was the "savior of the world." Paul declared Jesus as the savior and wrote in Ephesians 5:23 that Christ is the "Savior of the body." Later in Titus 2:13, he wrote, "looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ." Later in speaking of Christ as Savior, Paul wrote in 2 Timothy 1:10 that Jesus Christ had abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel." The apostle John wrote in 1 John 4:14, "And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son as Savior of the world."

Glorifying Jesus as *the Christ*. The word *Christ* appears over 500 times and in over 530 verses in the New Testament. *Baker Encyclopedia of the Bible* says, "In the NT the title is used in combination with the given name; as 'Jesus Christ' (Mt 1:1; Mk 1:1; Rom 1:4), and 'Christ Jesus' (Rom 1:1; 1 Cor 1:1), or with the article 'the Christ' (Rom 7:4), or with another title 'Lord Christ'" (Rom 16:18). The Bible teaches that the Christ should suffer (Acts 3:18). Paul proved that Jesus was the Christ in his preaching (Act 9:22).

Finally, glorifying Jesus as *our King*. The wise men from the East came to King Herod seeking the "new" King of the Jews who had just been born (Matt. 2:2). Herod would be told by the chief priests and scribes that Micah had predicted that a ruler would come out of Bethlehem who would shepherd Israel (Mic. 5:2). As Jesus was riding into Jerusalem on a colt, the multitude of disciples would rejoice and praise God by saying: "'Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!'" (Luke 19:38). John in the book of Revelation wrote of the beast with ten horns making war against the Lamb and that the Lamb would overcome them, "for He is Lord of Lords and King of Kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful" (17:14). John also wrote of Christ

riding on a white horse with the inscription on His thigh, "King of Kings and Lord of Lords" (Rev.19:16). Have you crowned Christ as King of your life?
