Thoughts from Bill:

Glorifying God (2)

Psalms 104:27-35

Last week we began a series of lessons on glorifying God and looked at the fact that glorifying God is a command. God deserves glory because of the various qualities that He possesses. In this lesson we want to look at the nature of the glory due God and motivations behind our giving glory to Him.

Various passages of scripture describe the nature our glory to God should take. The text for our lesson indicates that the glory given to God is *eternal* and based on His nature (Psa. 104:31). Psalms 104 begins with an exclamation of God's power and expresses His right to glory when the writer declares: "Bless the Lord, O my soul! O Lord my God, You are very great: You are clothed with honor and majesty." The

writer then gives example after example of God's power and declares his intention to glorify God as long as he lives (v. 32). John in Revelation 7 gives a glimpse of the great, innumerable multitude; the angels; the elders; and the four living creatures standing around the throne of God as they worshiped God, and their words echoed: ". . . Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, Thanksgiving and honor and power and might, Be to our God forever and ever. Amen" (Rev. 7:12). The nature of the glory of God is *great*. The Psalmist writes: "Yes, they shall sing of the ways of the Lord, For great is the glory of the Lord" (Psa. 138:5). The glory of the Lord is *highly exalted* (Psa. 8:1; 57:5; 113:4-5; 148:13).

We now want to consider the motivations for glorifying God. Christians should glorify God because *they have been bought with a price*, the precious blood of Jesus (1 Cor. 6:20; Rev. 5:9). Christians should glorify God *because of the example of Christ*. Christ while on earth glorified His Father (Jn. 13:31; 17:4). God deserves to be glorified because of all the *blessings He has bestowed on mankind* (Isa. 60:21; 61:3; 1 Cor. 10:31; James 1:17). Another motivation for giving glory to God is that one who glorifies God *may lead another to do so as well* (Matt. 5:16; 1 Pet. 2:12). Finally, we want to look at motivations based on the nature of God Himself. We can find motivation to glorify God simply *because of His name* (Deut. 28:28; Psa. 145:3). *God's majesty* should motivate us to glorify Him (Job. 37:22; Psa. 93:1; 145:5). *The power of God* should motivate us to glorify Him (Ex. 15:1-2, 6). The *works of God's hand* should give us motivation to glorify Him (Psa. 19:1; 111:3; 145:4, 5-6). Finally, on a negative note, we should be motivated to give glory to God because we will be lost if we fail to do so (Dan. 5:23-28; Rom. 1:21).

Again, I implore you, give glory to God!!!!

Psalms 104:33—I will sing to the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.
